Dear Parents/Guardians:

Welcome to Assumption Catholic School School. The following "Health Care Procedures" for the school are to help accomplish the goal of excellent health and safety of your child while in school or school related events.

1. The following forms must be completed and returned with the registration.
 2. 2011-2012 Student Emergency Information Form
 3. Up to date Immunization Record
 4. TB Student Questionnaire
 5. Signed copy of this Letter
- If your child has a severe health problem such as diabetes, asthma, epilepsy, severe allergies, heart conditions or other serious health conditions, doctor's orders, health care plans, medication and meeting with teachers, nurse, and principal must be done before the child can start school.
 - Any medication, prescription or over-the-counter, needs to have a physician or authorized prescriber and parent signature before the medication can be given at school. Cough drops, ointments, vitamins and others are considered to be medications. The parent must provide all medication in original containers to the school. The prescription medication must have a pharmacy label that matches orders. All medication must be brought to the school by the parent.
 - The child may carry medication such as an emergency asthma inhaler or Epipen if there is a doctor's order and proper procedure is followed. Certain medications will need to be in the classroom or with the coaches. A duplicate medication needs to be at the clinic as a back up. Parents will have to provide both. No other medication may be carried on the child, including over-the-counter medication, at school or school-related events.
 - The Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston Catholic Schools complies with the State of Texas Immunization requirements. Up-to-date immunization records are required to be returned to the school before registration is complete.
 - Texas Law requires vision, hearing, spinal and A/N screening. If screening norms are not met, a referral to a physician will be made.
 - A Student TB Screening Questionnaire or proof the child is under a doctor's care is required on all new and returning students.
 - A student will be sent home from school due to illness or injury. Exclusion and Readmission Guidelines is included and may be kept for reference.
